HOPE CAN HELP

Most of us know someone who is experiencing, or has experienced, cancer. The lifetime probability of developing any type of cancer is approximately 40 percent for males and 38 percent for females. That is to say, one in three women and one in three men will likely experience cancer during their life span.

It is only natural to seek out as many avenues of support and information as possible upon receiving a cancer diagnosis. Therefore, **HOPE** strives to ensure that every person with cancer has the opportunity to obtain access to current resources, empathy, and support.

We firmly believe in:

- showing compassion through caring, sharing, support, and outreach.
- building trust through respect, confidentiality and honesty.
- the renewal of spirit through fostering hope, providing emotional assistance and encouraging personal empowerment.
- the acceptance of all on our healing journey.
- working toward well-being through balancing and harmonizing psycho-social, spiritual, and physical elements of health and healing.
- developing personal empowerment through building awareness and providing education.
- dedication through commitment and cooperation, networking, and partnerships.
- the joyful celebration of life.

CLIENT ASSISTANCE

HOPE Cancer Help Centre Inc. is an amazing grass-roots organization that provides a unique service to people facing any type of cancer. The Saskatoon Cancer Centre, St. Paul's and City Hospital Palliative Care, the Royal University Hospital, and many doctors in the community contact **HOPE** requesting help for their patients facing cancer who might be in need of financial assistance and, unfortunately, are not able to obtain help from any other social agency.

Examples of Client Assistance may include:

- Medication to soothe the pain of radiation burn for an individual unable to afford the cost of the drug.
- Freezing of sperm for young men about to undergo chemotherapy or radiation treatment.
- Helping with yard work and housework for patients undergoing treatment.
- Food and shelter for families of children coming to Saskatoon for treatment.
- Out-of-town clients needing in-town accommodation AND in-town clients needing out-of-town accommodations.
- Helping those in palliative care find comfort during their final days.
- Providing telephone services to help patients keep in touch with friends and family while in palliative care or receiving in-hospital treatment.
- Assisting with the purchase of prosthesis—breast cancer, laryngectomy, etc.
- Assisting with the cost of special medical consultations/tests/treatments not locally available.

HEALING THROUGH RELAXATION AND MEDITATION

- Opportunity to learn the skill of meditation while sharing in a safe environment.
- Sessions are offered in 8 week cycles.

CANCOPE SUPPORT GROUP

- For cancer patients and survivors.
- Meetings include information sharing, discussion, and relaxation exercises.

ANNUAL LYMPHOEDEMA WORKSHOP

- Held on the last weekend in May.
- Facilitated by a Registered Physiotherapist.
- Patients experiencing swelling after treatment will be instructed in manual lymphatic drainage techniques.
- Register early! Space is limited!

WEEKEND RETREAT FOR PEOPLE FACING CANCER

- Annual retreat held in the autumn.
- 2 ½ days in length.
- Time to deal with the grief and trauma surrounding a cancer diagnosis - for patients and caregivers (*must be at least 19 years of age*).
- Time to network and relax.

ANNUAL RACE FOR RECOVERY

- Join us Sunday, April 25th, 2010.
- Walk 2 km or 5km~or~Run 5 km or 10 km.
- All funds from the Race for Recovery remain in Saskatchewan (including a donation of 10% for local research into quality of life issues).

SPECIAL FUNDRAISING EVENTS

- Throughout the year, **HOPE** holds a variety of events and projects to raise funds.
