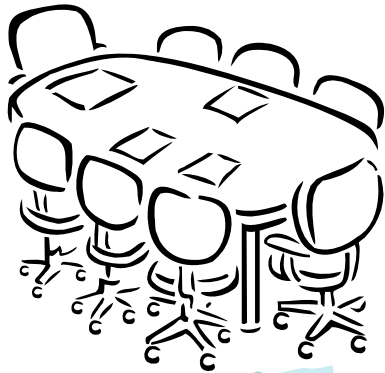
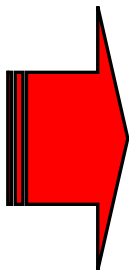

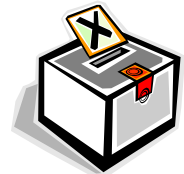

BANNER YEAR FOR CLIENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM:

The 2008-09 fiscal year was a busy one for the HOPE Cancer Help Centre – especially for the Client Assistance Program. A total of 153 requests were received for \$38,000 in financial assistance. These figures include referrals for 75 new clients and 15 previous clients. Generous donations from the community and through the Annual Race for Recovery and GJM Charity Classic made it possible for HOPE to provide such services as ambulance transportation for rural palliative care cancer patients, medications not covered by provincial or private drug programs, transportation and accommodations for patients needing to travel outside the province for treatments not available locally, plus many, many other services.
