

GJM CLASSIC CHARITY GOLF TOURNAMENT A GREAT SUCCESS!



In 2006, Garry Manson lost his short courageous battle with cancer. As a devoted family man and pillar of the community of Watrous, Garry is sadly missed. In 2007, to honour his memory and amazing life, his family established the GJM Charity Classic Tournament. The event was also established to help others by donating the proceeds from sponsors and team entries to other families experiencing cancer and the financial impact it may cause.

The Mansons hoped to raise \$5,000 from the first tournament. They set aside tee times for everyone to play in the afternoon. However, when the entries kept coming in, the Mansons decided to add the morning to the tournament as well. By the time all the registrations were received, 144 golfers participated and raised more than \$15,000!!!

In 2009, the Mansons chose the HOPE Cancer Help Centre Inc. as the organization to which they would direct the proceeds from the tournament. Once again, the event exceeded all expectations by raising \$18,900 for the HOPE Client Assistance Program.

This year, HOPE was once again selected to receive the proceeds from the tournament. It was feared that since green fees would now be factored into the expenses, the total raised would be considerably less. However, once again the community of Watrous came out in full force to honour Garry's memory. 153 golfers and friends enjoyed one of the few sunny days the summer of 2010 had to offer and managed to raise \$16,800 for HOPE!!!

This generous donation will greatly help the Client Assistance Program provide vital financial support for Saskatchewan cancer patients and their families. Over the past few years, Client Assistance requests have more than doubled. During the last fiscal year, HOPE provided \$40,000 in response to 213 requests. Thanks to the Mansons and the GJM Charity Classic Golf Tournament, HOPE will be able to respond to future requests.

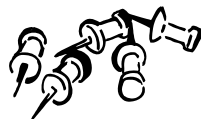

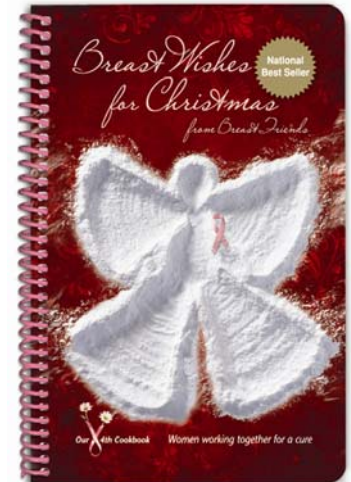
Just in time for the busy holiday season, the brand new Breast Friends Christmas cookbook is now available from the HOPE Cancer Help Centre!
